

## PCASA Rulebook changes 2023 to 2024

Page 18-19 – Rally Participation changes

Pg 20 Change to State Uniform

Pg 21 Riders do not need every rally attendance recorded on the performance card, but rather enough to show they are qualified

Pg 22 – Change to Performance Cards

Pg 23 Qualifications, change to timeframes.

Pg 28 – correct on who can upgrade cards

Page 30 – addition of “Where an event involves a cross country course a Printed Copy of the course map must be available for the Technical Delegate.” To rule 5.2

Pg 37 – change of Jim Toole award from yearly to bi-yearly

PG45 to 48 updating of certificate procedure & testing.

Page 58 – Clarification of rule & change to penalties

Blatantly wasting time in later stages of the course is defined as but not limited to the following, doing circles, loops, zigzags, and/or a reduction in speed by more than one pace.

Penalty for riders in Grades 6,5,4 will be additional 60 penalties added to score, riders Grades 3,2,1 will be Eliminated.

Page 67 Place Getters in a Super Cross Competition will be award points as per those allocated under the eventing rules.

Pg 73 add to rule 2 “depth of cups must not exceed 30mm, recommend if purchasing new cups to get those with maximum depth of 20mm.

Pg 54 & 73 WARM UP / PRACTICE FENCES

Due to horse welfare issues, excessive jumping of practice fences is not allowed, it is highly recommended that each practice fence be jumped no more than twice. It is recommended that event organisers have a marshal to monitor this activity.

Pg 76 Defining the number of show jumping rounds permitted per day

Pg 79 Rule 1.3.2 EQUALITY OF SCORES In case of equality of percentage for any of the first three places, the higher total of the collective mark/s, including coefficients

will decide on the placings, should there still be a tie, the rider score will be the final decider

Pg 82 – change to allocation of dressage points Combinations only need to accept points for one dressage test per competition, the riders may nominate on entry form which test they wish to have points for, if riders fail to nominate a specific test then the organisers may award points at their discretion.

Page 97 – Add Ring Tilting game

Page 110/111 Changes due to GR4 & 5 now been championship events, change to qualifications, change to cards

Pg 116 for clarification add to 3.1 'the competitions are to be run same way for both individual and team competitions.

Pg124/125 Amended/clarification of working equitation. Pages 122-126

Change of name – Working equitation to Ease of Handling.

Due to the change to Performance Cards there are various sections of rule book that have been modified to be aligned with the new card system

Removed reference to PCASA ODE as those grades now included in State Championship ODE, changed qualifications etc from Grades 3,2,1 to ALL Grades.
