## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**This event will be run under PCASA rules - riders must wear PCASA approved helmet and boots at all times when riding. Please present to Secretary's desk upon arrival for helmet to be date checked, and to receive wristbands for rings entered. All riders must be gear checked.**

1. Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club Association of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other persons.
2. A horse that is behaving dangerously and putting others at risk must be dismounted from and may be asked to leave the grounds. Stewards have the authority to remove from the ring any horse that is considered to be dangerous or to be interfering with other competitors.
3. NO STALLIONS OR COLTS ALLOWED ON GROUNDS.
4. NO DOUBLE BRIDLES TO BE WORN. PCASA approved gear to be worn. ALL riders must be gear checked before warming up.
5. Pony club competitors need to provide PCASA performance card, showing current financial membership with 2 qualifying rallies within 12 months of the competition and compete in full pony club uniform and approved pony club equipment.
6. PCASA Members need to provide a current financial PCASA card
7. EA Members must complete a PCASA waiver form along with a \$10 waiver payment (on Nominate)
8. Non PCASA/ EA members are able to compete but must sign a day participation form (on Nominate) with a fee of \$10 (poles on the ground allowed, but no show jumping allowed with this insurance).
9. Neat riding attire to be worn (PC riders to wear PC Uniform), plaiting is optional.
10. The judge's decision is final – there is to be no approach to the judge unless authorised by the convenor or steward.
11. Due to the nature of a multi-discipline show, events cannot be coordinated across rings. Competitors must consider overlapping events and prioritise classes accordingly. Classes will not be held with the exception of possibly the Championship classes (time permitting).
12. Led riders must remain led throughout the day.
13. ANY INCIDENT INVOLVING DAMAGE OR INJURY MUST BE REPORTED TO THE SECRETARY'S OFFICE.
14. Onkaparinga Pony Club committee reserves the rights to alter, cancel or delay any event, or combine any classes.
15. Hot weather policy: If the weather is to be in excess of 35c in Mount Barker (as announced on 7pm Channel 2 News the night prior) the gymkhana will be cancelled or postponed.
16. All riders must wear PCA approved helmets (please visit ponyclubsa.org.au for more information) and riding boots in all ridden events. No exceptions.
17. NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS, NO SMOKING.
18. Protests to be lodged in writing with Secretary within 10 minutes of the conclusion of event and be accompanied with a cash deposit of \$50. **The Disputes Committee decision will be final.**
19. EVACUATION PROCEDURES: in the event of a fire or other emergency all persons will be directed to the assembly area i.e. centre of the racecourse.
20. Ribbons for First, Second and Third unless otherwise stated.
21. Maiden – a horse/pony that has not won a first prize in an individual hack/rider class at ANY show
22. Riders that have won a first place in a class (as identified in program) are eligible for the Champion Class. Second place getters standby for Reserve Champion.
23. Pleasure classes- no whips or spurs allowed.

(TO ALLOW RIDERS TO DO ‘POLES ON THE GROUND’ IN SHOWJUMPING RING FIRST)

Riders to be 12 years and under in L Plate ring, and under 17 in P Plate ring. If a combination competes in a class led – they MUST be led for the remainder of the day. L plates = led ring. P plates = just off lead riders. Combinations can compete in either L or P classes, but not both. Age is as of the day of competition.
