PCASA Covid-19 Update 21st Nov 2020

Dear Members,

We hope you are doing well on our third and final day of lockdown here in South Australia!

Following yesterday's announcement that the lockdown would end early at 12.01 Sunday, November 22nd, the state government has today provided an update on community sport.

This morning, Police Commissioner Grant Stevens explained that community sport would not resume until at least December 1, 2020.

The new direction is more in line with what Premier Steven Marshall announced last Monday, November 16, cancelling community sport fixtures and training, both indoor and outdoor, for a two-week period.

As explained at the time, the possibility of an extension beyond December 1 remains.

If an extension was to occur, Pony Club Association of SA will work closely with clubs on what this means for the coming months of our sport.

Until then, we will await further direction from the state government.

As always, please continue to be vigilant and follow government guidelines – this will only better our chances of avoiding an extension of the two-week period.
