FRANCIS FIGWER MEMORIAL TROPHY

The Senior Francis Figwer Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the most successful **Southern Zone** club in the Pony Club Grades 1 & 2 classes. The Francis Figwer Trophy will be awarded to the most successful club in the Junior and Snr Grade 3 only (not adults). Points will be awarded to place getters and the club with the most points will be awarded the trophy.
